CONDITIONS OF ENTRY.

1. All exhibits must be registered with their respective breed societies and all members must be financial.

1A. INSURANCE: It is compulsory that ALL competitors, riders, handlers, drivers, strappers & grooms have Public Liability insurance to the sum of \$10,000,000. Some societies incorporate Public Liability Insurance into their membership fees. If a competitor DOES NOT have current cover, day membership/Insurance is available at a cost of \$14 PER PERSON who may be handling, riding, driving or strapping on the day. Day membership forms are attached to this program. If an exhibitor has current Public Liability Insurance coverage, through any Breed society, pony club etc, (THAT PROVIDES COVER AT EVENTS CONDUCTED BY ANOTHER SOCIETY,) then PROOF must be supplied at the time of entry, via a photocopy of membership/insurance card or waiver. THE ONUS IS ON THE COMPETITOR TO KNOW THEIR OWN INSURANCE STATUS AND TO COMPLY WITH THIS RULING.

2 All registration papers, foal recordings, cert of pregnancy must be produced on request.

3 All stallions/colts 2years & over must be bitted and shown by a competent handler 18yrs & over

4 All exhibits must be under effective control of a capable person, whether ridden or led.

5 All foals must be led.

6 All persons in charge of exhibits in the ring must be suitably attired. No advertising is allowed in the ring. All persons riding anywhere on the grounds, MUST wear a CURRENT safety approved helmet and riding boots.

7 Stewards have the right to remove from the ring any person not considered to be in effective control of their exhibit or who is considered unsuitably attired.

8 HOT WEATHER POLICY: If the Mt Pleasant forecast is to be 36 degrees or over on the BOM website, at Midday Saturday 22ND November, the show will be cancelled/postponed. The committee takes no responsibility if any exhibitor arrives at the show when it has been cancelled/postponed. The SABA will refund entries, less a \$5.00 administration fee.

9 The SA Buckskin Association Inc, will not accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or loss to horses, competitors or spectators or any of their belongings, or any other person or property.

10 All protests must be lodged with the secretary in writing within 15 minutes of completion of the class, accompanied by a \$100 fee which will be returned if the protest is upheld.

11 The committee reserves the right to refuse any entries.

12 The committee or designated representatives of the committee, reserves the right to inspect any animal on the grounds.

13 Ages of all horses and ponies calculated from 1st August unless otherwise stated. Ages of handlers/riders are as on the day of the show.

14 Entries close Midnight, Wednesday 19th November 2025. Entry fees are \$6/class. No phone entries will be accepted. Please ensure sufficient time for Australia Post to deliver.

15 Rings will be held at the judges' discretion only. The committee reserves the right to cancel or combine classes in the case of insufficient entries.

16 Horses that bear the prefix of the judge are ineligible. Exhibitors will be notified accordingly.

17 NO DOGS allowed on the grounds.

18 NO LUNGING ON THE OVAL BY ORDER OF THE TALUNGA PARK COMMITTEE.

19 The Judge's decision is FINAL.

20. EMAIL ENTRIES NOW ACCEPTED, ONLY IF ACCOMPANIED BY RELEVANT MEMBERSHIP/REGO'S INSURANCE WAIVER (WHERE APPLICABLE) AND A DIRECT DEPOSIT RECEIPT.

21. A fall of horse/rider or driver, is disqualification from that class. No person may remount or re enter the vehicle inside the ring.

22. The judge and/or steward has the right to remove from the ring, any exhibitor for inappropriate behaviour or language. The SABA committee reserves the right to request said person leave the showgrounds immediately.

23. OPEN classes are for any horse/pony, whether registered or unregistered.
